

The Ben-Zvi Institute for the Study of Jewish Communities in the East Fellowship Awards

2023

The Ben-Zvi Institute will award fellowships to MA students (who intend to or are writing a thesis), PhD students, and Post-doctoral students engaged in the study of Jewish communities in Muslim lands, Asia and Ethiopia as well as Sephardi communities in the east and west, in all academic disciplines.

The fellowships will be in the following amounts:

MA student – 6000 ILS

PhD students and Post-doctoral students – 9000 ILS

MA students and PhD students will be awarded half of the sum upon the occasion of the award ceremony; the remaining half will be given upon the completion and submittal of the Fellow's thesis.

MA students are required to submit their thesis within two years of receiving the fellowship.

PhD students are required to submit their dissertation within three years of receiving the fellowship.

Post-doctoral students are required to submit a research proposal for future research.

The Ben-Zvi Institute will be given first right of refusal for the publication of the Fellows' research.

To apply, please submit the following:

- 1. CV
- 2. Two recommendations
- 3. A completed application form (see attachment)

In addition, MA and PhD students will submit a detailed research proposal (no more than 3 pages). Post-doctoral students will submit a detailed research proposal (no more than 3 pages) and an abstract of their dissertation (no more than one page).
